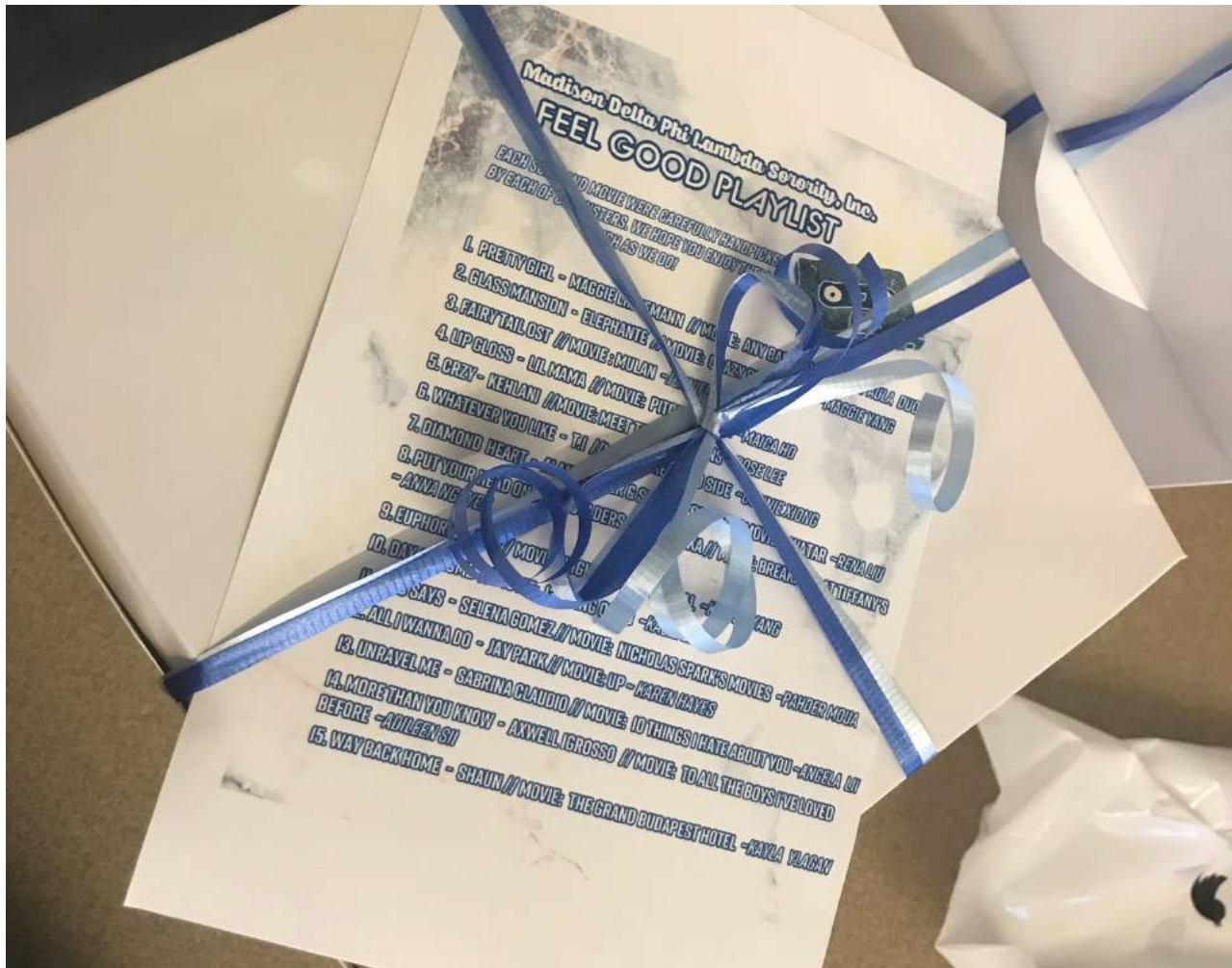

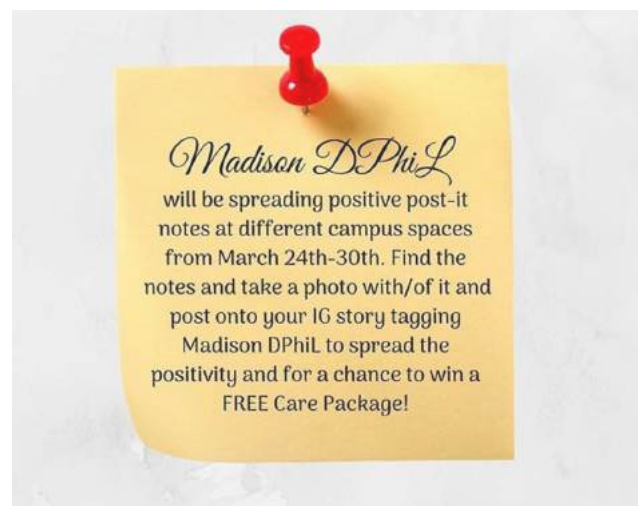
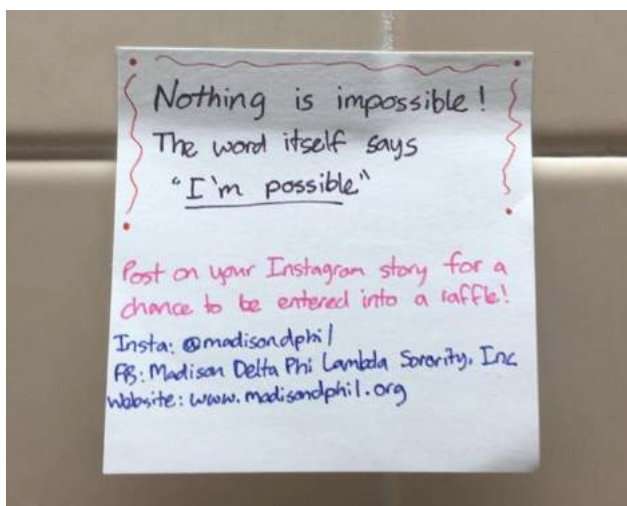

All of our sisters, including our Alumni, went to Double 10 Mini Hot Pot for dinner. We had a great time catching up. We also exchanged paddles within our lines!



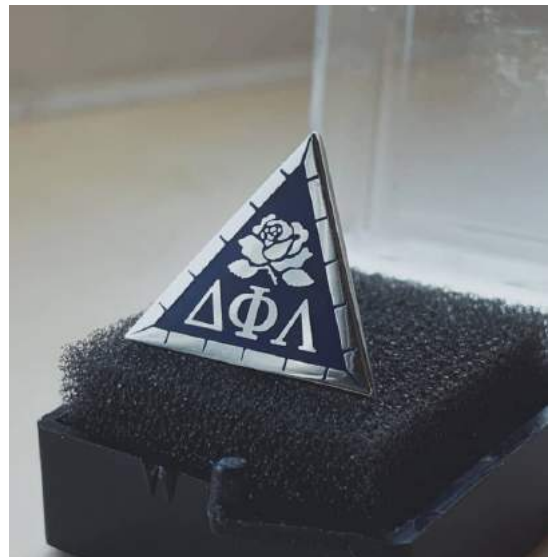


SISTER OF THE MONTH
